General

Specific

- 1. Approval of the over-arching institutional strategy for Access & Participation
- 2. Review and approval of the Access & Participation Plan
- 3. Review and approval of its associated Resource Plan that outlines how A&P countable monies committed within the Access & Participation Plan will be utilised for access, student success and progression.
- 4. To monitor KPIs milestones and targets outlined in the Access & Participation Plan and to ensure appropriate action is taken where they are not being met
- 5. Review and approval of in-year projects which are not included in Resource plan
- 6. To review and agree A&P monitoring return
